



## **KYRIE - Sung Twice**


The words "kyrie eleison" are an ancient prayer meaning "Lord have mercy" The term "Kyrie/Lord" usually referred to a worldly ruler such as an emperor and asking the Kyrie for mercy was a legal plea. It was a subversive thing for the early church to proclaim that Jesus is Lord and not the imperial power.

The holy gospel according to Luke.


# Glory to you, O Lord.


You are invited to prepare your table with the food and drink that will be the Body and Blood of Christ for us,


For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.
