#### FIRST READING: Isaiah 35:1-10

The glory of Lebanon shall be given to it, the majesty of Carmel and Sharon.

the unclean shall not travel on it, but it shall be for God's people; no traveler, not even fools, shall go astray.


<sup>9</sup>No lion shall be there, nor shall any ravenous beast come up on it;

This third Sunday of Advent, are reminded of the joy at the promise of God's justice coming in the Christ Child.



The farmer waits for the precious crop from the earth, being patient with it until it receives the early and the late rains. <sup>8</sup>You also must be patient. Strengthen your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is near. <sup>9</sup>Beloved, do not grumble against one another, so that you may not be judged. See, the Judge is standing at the doors! <sup>10</sup>As an example of suffering and patience, beloved, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord.




#### GOSPEL: Luke 1:26-33, 46-55





Gathered into one by the Holy Spirit, let us pray as Jesus taught us.



Be strong, do not fear! Here is your God, who has come to save you.


